Welcome to Worship

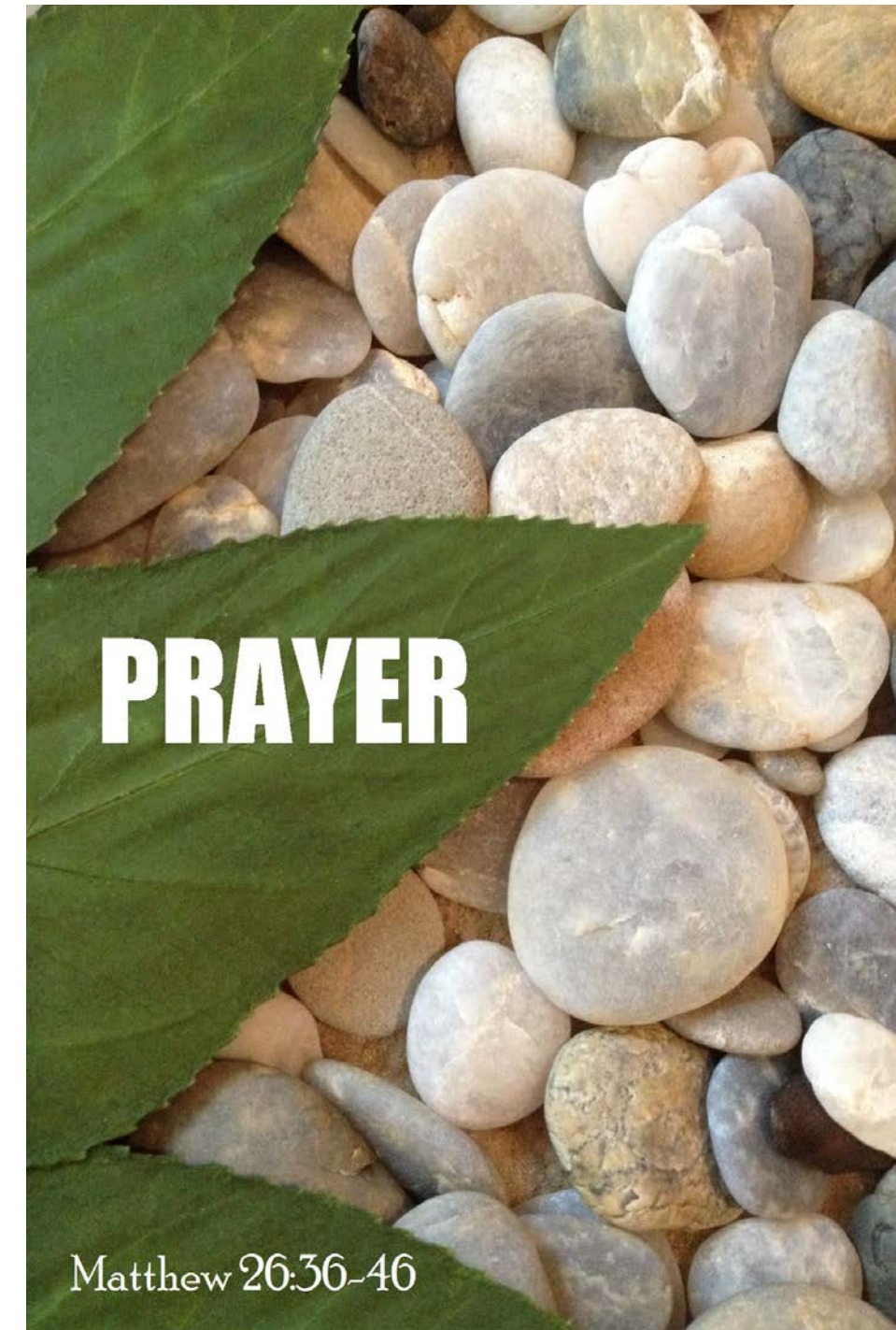
